#### In accordance with the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act,

After-school Pick-ups: In order to allow parents to pick-up their students as quickly as possible after school, please follow these procedures:

- Stay to the right when approaching the school building.
- When your vehicle is in the "pickup lane" beside the sidewalk in front of the school, pull your vehicle as far forward as possible. Your student(s) will walk down the sidewalk to meet your vehicle. Unless you are actively loading a student, there should not be a large space in front of your vehicle.

#### Parking Lot Safety Procedures:

• Please drive carefully, and do not back up in the pick-up line because there may be children behind you. Remember that the traffic pattern is **ONE WAY** for your safety. Do not go immediately left to the parking area.
