An Intent for Re-Enrollment form for the 2024-2025 school year was sent home a few weeks ago to be submitted by **March 1**. It will also need to be accompanied by a \$35/child or \$75/family minimum deposit which will be applied toward the \$300/child early registration fee with the balance due by June 15, 2024. This early deposit will lock families into the \$300 registration fee rate until June 15th. All families that register between March 2nd and July 1st will pay a \$400 registration fee. Families that register after July 1st will be charged a \$430 registration fee.
