An Intent for Re-Enrollment form for the 2024-2025 school year was sent home a few weeks ago to be submitted by March 1. It will also need to be accompanied by a $\$ 35 /$ child or $\$ 75 /$ family minimum deposit which will be applied toward the $\$ 300 /$ child early registration fee with the balance due by June 15, 2024. Families that register after July $1^{\text {st }}$ will be charged a $\$ 430$ registration fee.
